



Get books on your Kindle from Amazon

You will need to know your Amazon account login. Setting up an Amazon account requires an email address and credit card.

1. On your computer, go to listenupvermont.org.
2. Select **Sign in** on the menu at the top of the page.
3. Select **South Burlington Community Library** from the list and enter your 14-digit library card number on the next page.
4. Browse or search for eBook titles. It must be a “Kindle Book.” Note that some Kindle books are available for wireless download, while others require downloading via USB cable.

Librarian Search Tips:

Titles that say **Add to Basket** are available immediately. Titles that say **Join Waiting List** are checked out. If you join the waiting list you will receive an email when the title is available. You can limit your search to titles **Available Now**.

5. Once you have chosen an available title, select **Add to Basket**. You may **Continue Browsing** to add up to 2 more titles.
6. With your selection(s) in your basket, select **Proceed to Checkout**.
7. Choose a 7- or 14-day lending period. Click **Confirm Checkout**.
8. Click **Get for Kindle**.
9. You will be redirected to Amazon, which is unaffiliated with the South Burlington Community Library. Click the yellow **Get Library Book** button.



10. Sign in to the Amazon account that your Kindle is linked to.
11. Select the device you want the book delivered to.
12. The book will automatically appear on your device the next time it connects to Wi-Fi, or choose to **Download Now** when prompted. Connect the Kindle to your computer via USB cable, then click **Download**.
